A short reflection on today's Gospel Matthew 16:21-27

Jesus' teaching in today's Gospel is clear, cogent, and hard-hitting: the way of the world is not God's way. Glory and success in worldly terms is not glory and success in terms of eternal life. Peter is told this roundly by his beloved master, who is already looking into the terrible face of his own impending suffering and death.

'Take up your cross and follow me,' Jesus tells us. In other words, learn to give up control, get out of the driver's seat, face the pain, embrace God's way, not our own. One of the most important insights we can be gifted with is that facing our own pain and the pain in the world rather than turning away from either is to open the floodgates of true compassion as never before. Someone once said that to look on Jesus crucified is to soften our hearts towards all suffering, and, indeed, to understand more fully the compassionate heart of God.

Jesus, teach us to embrace God's way, not the way of the world. Remind us that when we stumble and fall into the pit of suffering, there lies the gift of compassion, the treasure of spiritual wisdom.

Jesus, teach us to remember the words of Bro. Charles de Foucauld: 'Father, I abandon myself into your hands; do with me what you will.'
