A short reflection on today's Gospel John 1: 29-34

One of the many satisfying things about John the Baptist is that despite the vast crowds flocking to him, drawn to his powerful, unconventional presence and his passionate beautiful ministry, he always remains true to who he is in God's eyes: he is the one who is preparing the way for his Lord and Master, whose sandal, he insists in his humility, he is not fit to tie. He, John, baptises with water but the Son of God will baptise with the Holy Spirit and with fire. And now, in today's Gospel, God reveals to John that Jesus is His Son; Jesus is the new Paschal Lamb; he is the living, breathing joy of God's love for humankind.

Jesus, John, like you taught us that repentance is our path to forgiveness. The word 'repent' means 'to change direction;' in other words, to turn away from one's sinfulness, and to turn one's face to the light of God's forgiveness. Let us accept this as a challenge to spiritual torpor, self-satisfaction, and attachment to worldly power and repent of our sinfulness with truth and courage.

Let us embrace with the passionate conviction of John, our baptism with the Holy Spirit and with fire.

The St Dymphna Mass will be celebrated here at St Eugene's Cathedral on Tuesday 17th January at 7.30pm. This Mass is to give thanks to God for positive mental health and to pray for those who are struggling with mental health issues and those who care for them.

As a parish community we look forward to the ordination of Deacon Michael McCaul to the Priesthood here at St Eugene's Cathedral on Sunday 29th January at 3.00pm. Everyone is welcome. We ask you Lord Jesus, to fill Michael with the fire of your love, that his ministry may reveal your presence in the Church.
