A short reflection on today's Gospel John 6:51-58

My flesh is real food and my blood is real drink

What we learn in today's Gospel is at the heart of our faith: Christ is the life-giving bread awaiting our hunger. St Augustine echoes what Jesus tells us in today's Gospel: God is the food and all we have to do is to provide the hunger. We know that God is in Jesus and Jesus promised that he would never leave us, that he would be with us forever. This is made manifest when, as a community of faith, we submit ourselves fully to the miracle of the Eucharist, to its constant and completely unearned grace. When we give ourselves over fully to the unearned grace of the Eucharist we experience profound gratitude and transformative joy. Someone once stated that sinners are, more often than not, more hungry than 'saints', a statement which is at once comforting, provocative and challenging, a statement which comforts our guilty selves, challenges our spiritual inertia, and provokes us into opening ourselves fully to our hunger for God and the appeasement of that hunger in the Eucharist.

Jesus, help us to empty ourselves of pride, egotism and self-righteousness, all of which leave no room for our hunger for God.

Jesus, may we always remember that when we receive the unearned grace of the Eucharist, we take into ourselves your life, your death, your surrender to the will of your Father. In other words we take into ourselves your great gift of yourself. Help us to take the time to sit with you and meditate on this truth with humble gratitude. Amen.
