# A short reflection on today's Gospel Matthew 25:14-30

The parable Jesus relates to his disciples in today's Gospel does not, as has sometimes been suggested, justify a gospel of economic prosperity. Like all the parables Jesus relates, the parable of the man who goes abroad and entrusts his property to his servants merits deep and careful reading. What it emphasises is the certainty of the Lord's return and the crucial importance of emulating the ministry of Jesus while we wait. It is not a flag-waving celebration of capitalism.

What did Jesus do when he was on earth?

He healed the sick. He comforted the despised and the marginalised. He forgave his enemies. He refused to conform to human commandments masquerading as divine commandments. He endured agonising suffering without a word of complaint. He fed the hungry. He cherished the beauty and innocence of children and set them before us as models to emulate. This is the message of today's Gospel: to rise to the challenge of emulating Jesus using whatever God has given us; to endure through the hard times; to love, to forgive time and time again; to heal rather than to inflict pain; to cherish children; to till the patch of earth we have been given and leave it in a better state for those precious children.

Jesus, may we follow your way of light and love always.
