# A short reflection on today's Gospel Mark 6:30-34

Today's Gospel witnesses Jesus as solicitous, selfless, compassionate; a loving, caring shepherd who puts the needs of his flock before his own.

His beloved disciples have returned exhausted from the mission entrusted to them by their master. Recognising their weariness and moved by it, Jesus suggests that they go to an isolated place, far away from the crowds, where they can rest and recover their strength. But the people in their desperate need to hear Jesus and experience his healing are relentless. They follow him. Jesus understands the desperate yearning for truth and healing overflowing in the hearts of the people and his response is one of compassion. He sees them as sheep without a shepherd, and despite his own fatigue, he rouses himself and ministers generously to their needs.

Jesus, through your response to your beloved disciples' exhaustion, you remind us of our need to find a 'lonely place' in times of unbearable stress, a place in which we can rest and recover our strength through quiet, deep communion with our Heavenly Father.

Jesus, may we fully appreciate your compassionate response to those people in need, a response which overrode your fatigue and caused you to reach out with love and care for those you saw as 'sheep without a shepherd'. May we, too, find that same compassionate care for others; may we recognise their need as greater than our often weary disinclination to help.
