# A short reflection on today's Gospel Luke 1:39-45

Mary, the spiritually beautiful, innocent young girl who accepted the full enormity of God's will for her with humility and grace, in today's Gospel displays an awe-inspiring humanity. Vulnerable in her own early pregnancy, she nevertheless braves the long and potentially dangerous journey from Nazareth to the mountain of Judah to be with her elderly, miraculously pregnant, kinswoman, Elizabeth. In an extraordinary example of love and compassion in action she puts her own needs and fears to one side and faces with equanimity an experience which would have daunted older hearts.

When the kinswomen embrace we are immediately in a world which is quintessentially female: a world of mutual recognition of the awesome miracle of childbirth. Elizabeth's words to Mary show that she has been made aware of the great honour God has granted to her cousin. Her awe in Mary's presence is palpable. Mary's humanity in today's Gospel is truly beautiful in the selflessness, compassionate love and generosity it displays.

Jesus, teach us how to be truly human in today's world which seems to be riven with fear and anger. Teach us, Jesus, to till the patch of earth we have being given and leave it a better place for our children. Jesus, may we respond to the world's fear and anger with your blessed mother's beautiful humanity: with love, compassion; with faith, humility and courage. Amen
