A short reflection on today's Gospel

Today's Gospel gives us a vivid account of the resurrected Jesus' encounter with two of his disciples, Cleopas and another unnamed disciple. Having left Jerusalem in the aftermath of the death of their beloved Jesus, they are on their way to Emmaus and their excited conversation expresses their sense of confusion and incomprehension in the face of the events they have recently experienced. When they are joined by Jesus, they do not recognise him, but include him in their distracted talk. They are enthralled as he enlightens their understanding of Scripture in relation to the Messiah's Passion, death, and resurrection. Still not recognising Jesus, on reaching Emmaus they invite him to stay the night. Only when he sits at table with them, breaks bread and hands it to them, do they fall at his feet in joyful recognition.

Jesus walks with us throughout our lives, even if we do not always recognise him; even if we do not always feel the gentle strength of his hand holding ours. He never leaves us, never abandons us to walk alone in the dark. He walks beside us steadfastly, his shining truth lighting the way through the darkness to the glory of eternal life. If we feel abandoned, it is because we have withdrawn our hand from his and turned away from him. He never turns from us.

Jesus, the disciples recognised you from the breaking of bread. When we consume the Eucharist, may our hearts sing with the joy of our glorious union with you.

Jesus, may we never fail to recognise you in the faces of the poor, the dispossessed, the lonely, the betrayed, and may we never turn away from you in blind indifference.
