A short reflection on today's Gospel Matthew 20:1-16 Why be envious because I am generous?

The story that Jesus tells his disciples in today's Gospel turns humanity's obsession with entitlement on its head. Human beings are forever keeping score, forever counting and checking. Who is deserving of more than someone else! Who has got away with more than they deserve! The concept of undeserved kindness and generosity, the concept of undeserved mercy, appals those who don't recognise God's world as a world of grace, a world in which there is no such thing as entitlement, a world in which everything is free. Today's Gospel throws out the rules we insist are so important.

A sense of entitlement, a sense of special rights, is an indication of love of ourselves rather than love of God; it may nourish the ego but it surely starves the soul. Jesus, may we remind ourselves daily that the kingdom of heaven runs on grace. May we accept humbly that in this kingdom of grace God's undeserved mercy and love reigns supreme.

Jesus, may we be alive to the undeserved love of God we experience time after time in our lives, and put aside any sense of entitlement and special rights we may be harbouring. May we express instead profound gratitude, humility, wonder and awe in the light of God's amazing grace.
