A short reflection on today's Gospel Luke 1:26-38

Today's beautiful, awe-inspiring Gospel witnesses the young virgin Mary saying 'Yes' to God's will for her. Her humble acceptance of her appointed role is truly remarkable. She says 'Yes' to the life which will soon be sheltering within her body. She says 'Yes' to raising that child to manhood with loving, tender care. And she says, 'Yes' to the 'sword which will one day pierce both their sides.' Mary says 'Yes' to life, to its light, to its love, and to its darkness. She makes no claims of deserving her God-appointed role as the mother of the Saviour of mankind: 'I know I am not worthy – but let it be!' Her quiet wisdom is extraordinary, her composure awe-inspiring.

Jesus, may we, like Mary, your mother, say 'Yes' to life. May we accept that all experience is designed to teach us valuable truths. May we come to understand that we can learn as much through our experience of the darkness of suffering as we can learn through our experience of the light.

Jesus, may we, like Mary, your mother, let God's will be done to us. May we never forget God's infinite love for us, undeserved love, freely given.
