A short reflection on today's Gospel: *Matthew 28: 16-20*

Go and make disciples of all nations

Today's Gospel is powerful. It is Jesus' final instructions to his beloved disciples before he returns to his Father. He came from God, lived his life through God, and is about to return to God; but not before he promises to complete the fulfilment of God's plan by sending the third person of the Trinity, the Holy Spirit, to his disciples to enlighten them further. It is significant that Jesus completes his mission in Galilee, the place where his mission started: it is time for him to complete the circle of their time together on earth: to bid farewell to these friends, so beloved of him, so human in their fears and their confusion; so dazed by the cataclysmic events they have witnessed that some of them even doubt the evidence of their own eyes. But Jesus has total faith in them: he entrusts the universal mission of the Church to them: 'Go and make disciples of all nations,' he instructs them, making it clear that theirs was not to be an enclosed community, but a community reaching to the ends of the earth.

'And know that I am with you always; yes, to the end of time.'

Jesus, you have given your disciples a very precise mission: to baptise believers in the name of the Holy Trinity, and to teach them God's will. And you have made your disciples the very beautiful promise that you will always be with them.

Jesus, may we never forget that if we wish to call ourselves your disciples, we must always proclaim your Good News of salvation, and we must do this, not only with words, but by living out your message of love. If our daily lives do not speak of love and compassion, generosity and forgiveness, we have no right to call ourselves your disciples.

Jesus, may we deserve your presence in our lives always by allowing love to be at the centre of our lives, informing our every word and action, our every thought and prayer. Amen.

The plan identifies actions and behaviours that support rather than destroy the environment. The suggestions cover such areas as land, buildings, energy, food, travel and waste. Every attempt has been made to make the Strategy both comprehensive and practical so as to suit each parish's particular situation. 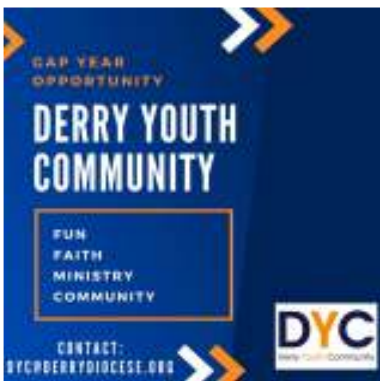

Blessed Carlos Acutis

Blessed Carlo Acutis, an Italian Catholic teenager, was beatified in Assisi, Italy on 10th October 2020. He documented Eucharistic miracles around the world and catalogued them all onto a website that he created himself in the months before his death from leukaemia. Carlo was known for his cheerfulness, his care for others, his computer skills and his deep devotion to the Eucharist, saying it was his “highway to heaven”.
