## A short Gospel reflection Luke 21:5-19

In today's Gospel, Jesus warns his followers of troubling events to come—wars, famine, plagues, and earthquakes. He tells them that those who remain faithful to his name will face persecution and suffering. Yet, in the midst of these trials, Jesus assures his disciples of his unfailing presence: he will never abandon those who stand firm in faith and love, even when faced with cruelty and injustice.

Throughout the history of the Church, the apocalyptic words of Jesus have echoed in every generation. Times of hardship and upheaval have always been opportunities for his followers to bear witness to the Gospel with courage and hope. Today, our challenges may take different forms. Rampant materialism tempts us to believe that happiness can be bought, while cynicism dismisses faith as outdated or naïve. But the human heart still longs for light, for peace, and for rest—longings that can only be fulfilled in God.

Now is the time to renew our commitment to Christ and to live out our faith boldly. The message of today's Gospel is clear: following Jesus is not easy, and it can even be costly. Yet, the rewards are beyond measure. Walking with Jesus leads us to the very heart of Love itself—and ultimately, to the glory of the resurrection.

**Prayer for Vocations to the Priesthood**: As Jesus asks us all in today's gospel, we pray for our seminarians and the men discerning a vocation to the diocesan priesthood, that they will be strong and faithful witnesses to Christ, especially in the face of persecution, criticism, or opposition.
