A short Gospel reflection Matthew 24:37-44

In today's Gospel, Jesus invites us to live with a spirit of watchful readiness. He reminds us that just as people in Noah's time carried on with ordinary life unaware of what was coming, we too can become absorbed in daily routines and miss the presence of God moving quietly in our midst.

Jesus is not trying to frighten us, but to awaken us. Our readiness is not about predicting dates or living in anxiety; it is about living each day rooted in faith, charity, and prayer. When our hearts are open, the Lord's coming—whether in moments of grace, in the needs of others, or at the end of our earthly journey—will not catch us off guard.

As Advent begins, this Gospel calls us to spiritual alertness. What distractions keep us from noticing God's presence? Where might Christ be inviting us to grow, to reconcile, or to serve? Let us stay awake, not out of fear, but out of love for the One who comes to save.

Prayer for Vocations to the Priesthood: As we celebrate the First Sunday of Advent we pray for our seminarians and the men discerning a vocation to the diocesan priesthood, that they will prepare their hearts and minds to welcome the Lord Jesus into their lives.
